# The Twelve Days of Christmas 2021

The 12 days of Christmas have within them several major feasts, some of which are little known by the average churchgoer. Of course, everyone knows of the Feast of the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, which falls on 25 December, and the Feast of the Epiphany, which falls on 6 January, and which we will celebrate with the Eucharist at 10:00 a.m., ending Christmastide. We will also celebrate the Feasts of St. Stephen on 27 December with a Eucharist at 10:00 a.m. (transferred from the 26th because it falls on a Sunday), St. John on 28 December with a Eucharist at 10:00 a.m., the Holy Innocents on 29 December with a Eucharist at 12:15 p.m., and the Holy Name on 1 January, with a Eucharist at 10am. These wonderful feasts give shape to the 12 days of Christmas and provide a depth of meaning to our celebration of the Incarnation. Won't you join us as we observe the fullness of the season?
