St. John's Book Club

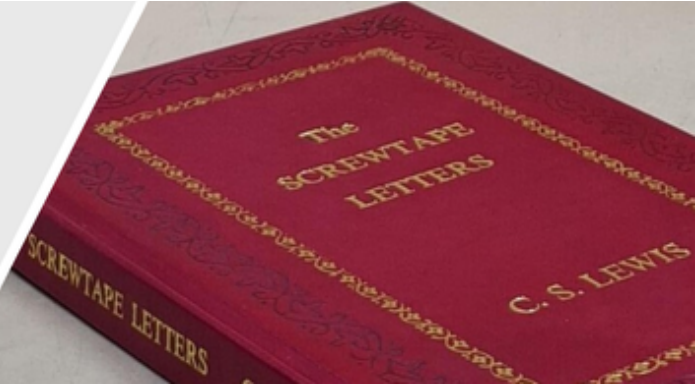
November Meeting - Tuesday, November 18 at 3:30 p.m.
