Men's Kairos Prison Ministry Weekend

The Men's Kairos Prison Ministry Weekend (#36) was held at Sumter Correctional Institution on November 13–16 and November 22, with two St. John's parishioners serving in leadership roles. Twenty-four residents were selected from 148 applicants to participate in this short course in Christianity, which included talks, small-group discussions, chapel meditations, music, and a closing graduation ceremony. The weekend was a meaningful time of spiritual growth and reflection for the participants, who engaged deeply with the program and with one another.
